Your teen driver will learn why cars do what they do, how they should react, how to properly control a car, and how to take care of their cars! Everything anyone should know before getting behind the wheel and on the highways!

You and your teen will spend the day with knowledgeable and highly skilled driving instructors of the Northern Virginia Corvette Club. Under carefully controlled conditions in their normal vehicles (or their parents'), we will put your young drivers through a series of exercises designed to extend driving skills and awareness of the road, as well as learn about safety and car maintenance! Attendance includes a fabulous pizza lunch from a local pizza place, for both parent and teen.

At least one parent or guardian must accompany each teen driver throughout the day! They will attend classroom sessions and ride with their teens as they drive through exercises designed to help the new driver understand why they might lose control and how to prevent it. In the process, many parents say that they learn a lot, too!

All of this is done at very slow speeds in a carefully designed, safe environment. It is far better for them to know what to do beforehand, in controlled conditions, than to experience a problem out on the highway or public roads and not know what to do!

This driving school is free, but the class size is limited to 30. These events fill up fast, so register ASAP! CORVETTE CLUB MEMBERSHIP IS NOT REQUIRED! Registration Closes Friday, November 15, 2013.

Certain limitations apply: We CANNOT accept day of class drive-ins, SUVs or vans (for safety reasons)!!! Car sharing must be approved before the day of class. The teen driver must have a learner's permit or valid driver's license to participate.

More information will be available to parents and teens that register early. Confirmations will be emailed to all participants, which will have additional information about the event, so please give a valid email address when registering!



Bowling Green Assembly has produced approximately 1,000 Stingrays for customers thus far. Most of these vehicles are expected to be delivered to dealers within the next few weeks. The National Corvette Museum today received our first shipment of R8C Delivery Corvettes with our first "C7" Delivery

slated for September 30 when the plant will re-open to customers participating in R8C, Buyers Tours or Photo Albums through the Museum.

For those of you that have been waiting to catch a glimpse of a C7, we will have them on the floor for display starting tomorrow (Friday)!

Per our August 13 NVCC GBM - GM needs a VIN to check out what I

heard on local radio late August 13 regarding highway patrols (somewhere) discovered/ reported recurring incidents where subject Vette headlights went out and caught fire with wiring so close to the engine. I was able to talk to a Customer Assistance Rep who said if true it would be investigated and that could take some time. GM recommends Vette owners search by their VIN. That's all I could find out. Good luck. Yours may be safe...so far...but, I recommend you keep checking your VIN online or sign up for alerts. I have provided the GM URL below.






VIR NCM HPDE
