

Part of the joy of owning a Corvette is knowing your car has all the right stuff—the right combination of power, handling, and styling to be a winner in just about any situation. To help experience the full measure of enjoyment in owning a Corvette, you owe it to yourself to consider joining the **Northern Virginia Corvette Club (NVCC)**.

Founded in 1969, NVCC is a group of individuals whose backgrounds and interests are diverse, but who share a common bond—the love of Corvettes and having fun with them. NVCC offers a wide range of activities for Corvette enthusiasts. They include:

Autocross: Timed competition on a closed course designed to test the skill and reflexes of the driver as well as the Corvette's acceleration, braking and handling. Autocross courses are set up with traffic pylons through which one car at a time must navigate.

HPDE: At a High Performance Driving Event you learn to drive your car on a circuit track as if you were a racecar driver, although this is not a timed event. You will be taught to drive as close to race speeds in the straights and turns as you can while maintaining safety. Novice and intermediate drivers have instructors guiding them from the passenger seat.

Concours: From the term "concours d'elegance," literally "a gathering of elegance." A concours is a show competition in which Corvettes are judged for cleanliness and/or authenticity. Classes include street driven, pure stock, custom, and race prepared. NVCC plans a major annual concours each year with the help of its sponsor, Jim McKay Chevrolet, for the purpose of preparing and exhibiting Corvettes and for attracting the public.



Rallyes: Events in which a team of driver and navigator follow a list of clues and instructions to get from a starting point to a finishing point. Unlike "time/speed/distance" rallyes, NVCC rallyes are more the "seat of the pants" variety, relying on trick clues, questions and other gimmicks to challenge participants. Poker rallyes are combined with the collection of playing cards during the course of the rallye for winners of the high and low hands.

Social Events: NVCC members also participate in a wide variety of social events including scenic road cruises, picnics, car shows, parades, day or weekend trips, go-karting, drag racing, and an annual banquet. Most are designed for family participation.

Service: Serving the community is another important club function. The NVCC holds a Teen Driving School available free of charge to students and regularly raises and donates funds to area charities.

Restoration & Modification: NVCC members also serve as a talent and resource pool for each other, sharing experiences and Corvette knowledge. Whether you are interested in racing, restoration/rebuilding or concours, there's someone in the club who can help with advice, information or an extra pair of hands to help tackle that big job.

NVCC is recognized by the National Council of Corvette Clubs (NCCC), a nationwide organization.

NCCC sanctions hundreds of events each year that are hosted by member clubs. Participants in these events, which usually consist of concours, rallye or autocross activities, earn points toward NCCC annual championship trophies. NCCC establishes standard competition rules for these events.

NOTE: An initiation fee of \$10 must accompany this application (fee waived for Jim McKay Corvettes – see below). Prerequisites for membership in NVCC are attendance at two club events (including one General Business Meeting) during a four-month period following receipt of your application. After you have completed these requirements, your application will be reviewed by the NVCC Council. Upon acceptance, you will be assessed dues in the amount of \$83 for the first year, which includes \$48 for NVCC dues and \$35 mandatory NCCC dues. (NCCC dues are \$25 after the first year.) Spouses may also join. Yearly fees for a spouse are \$24 for NVCC and \$10 for NCCC.

Purchasers of Corvettes from Jim McKay Chevrolet will receive a free membership of 1 year to the NVCC, subject to completion of the above initiation process for joining. Membership into the NCCC is not a part of this agreement, and NCCC dues would be required to be a recognized member of the NCCC. At the end of your 1 year free membership into the NVCC, you will be assessed regular dues (see above for dues amounts).
